

GUIDELINES FOR PATROL SHOPPING

WHEN SHOPPING FOR FOOD FOR YOUR PATROL FOR A CAMPOUT THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES SHOULD BE FOLLOWED:

- q SHOPPING DUTIES SHOULD BE ROTATED AMONG PATROL MEMBERS
- q TWO PATROL MEMBERS SHOP TOGETHER
- q RECEIPTS ARE TO BE KEPT AND TURNED IN WITH LEFTOVER MONEY FRIDAY NIGHT BEFORE THE CAMPOUT
- q IF YOU SPEND MORE THAN YOU ARE GIVEN YOU MUST MAKE UP THE EXTRA
- q MENUS AND DUTY ROSTERS ARE TO BE APPROVED
- q MENUS AND DUTY ROSTERS ARE TO BE BROUGHT TO THE CAMPOUT
- q ALL MEALS ARE TO BE COOKED
- q DUTY ROSTERS MUST BE FOLLOWED

THE TROOP IS RESPONSIBLE FOR SUPPLYING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS AND SHOULD NOT BE BOUGHT WITH PATROL MONEY, HOWEVER A LIST OF ITEMS NEEDED SHOULD BE SUBMITTED TO THE TROOP QUARTERMASTER TO INSURE THAT THE ITEMS WILL BE AVAILABLE:

- q DISH SOAP
- q KETCHUP
- q MUSTARD
- q KOOL AID
- q HOT CHOCOLATE (WINTER ONLY)
- q JELLO (WINTER ONLY)
- q CUP-A-SOUP (WINTER ONLY)
- q ALUMINUM FOIL
- q COOKING OIL
- q PAPER TOWELS
- q TOILET PAPER
- q POTS/PANS/COOKING/UTENSILS
- q BLEACH

MANY TIMES THE TROOP WILL ALSO HAVE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS. CHECK WITH THE QUARTERMASTER TO SEE IF THEY ARE AVAILABLE.

- q CRACKERS
- q OATMEAL
- q POP TARTS
